We have had a change in plans for our I-99 opening celebration and now invite you to join us a day earlier (November 24) to officially open the southbound lanes of I-99.

The ceremony is now scheduled for Monday, November 24, at 11 a.m. on I-99 southbound, just west of the current Valley Vista exit. Traffic control will be on hand to assist attendees getting into the ceremony site. Attendees traveling I-99 northbound to the ceremony will need to exit at the Toftrees interchange and re-enter current Route 322 westbound at Toftrees to access the ceremony site. Please refer to the enclosed map for details.

Our ceremony will feature comments from area dignitaries, followed by a ribbon cutting and vehicle procession down the southbound lanes. Opening of the southbound lanes signifies that the entire stretch of I-99 in Centre County is open to traffic and that drivers can travel from the PA Turnpike at Breezewood all the way to I-80 at Bellefonte on I-99.

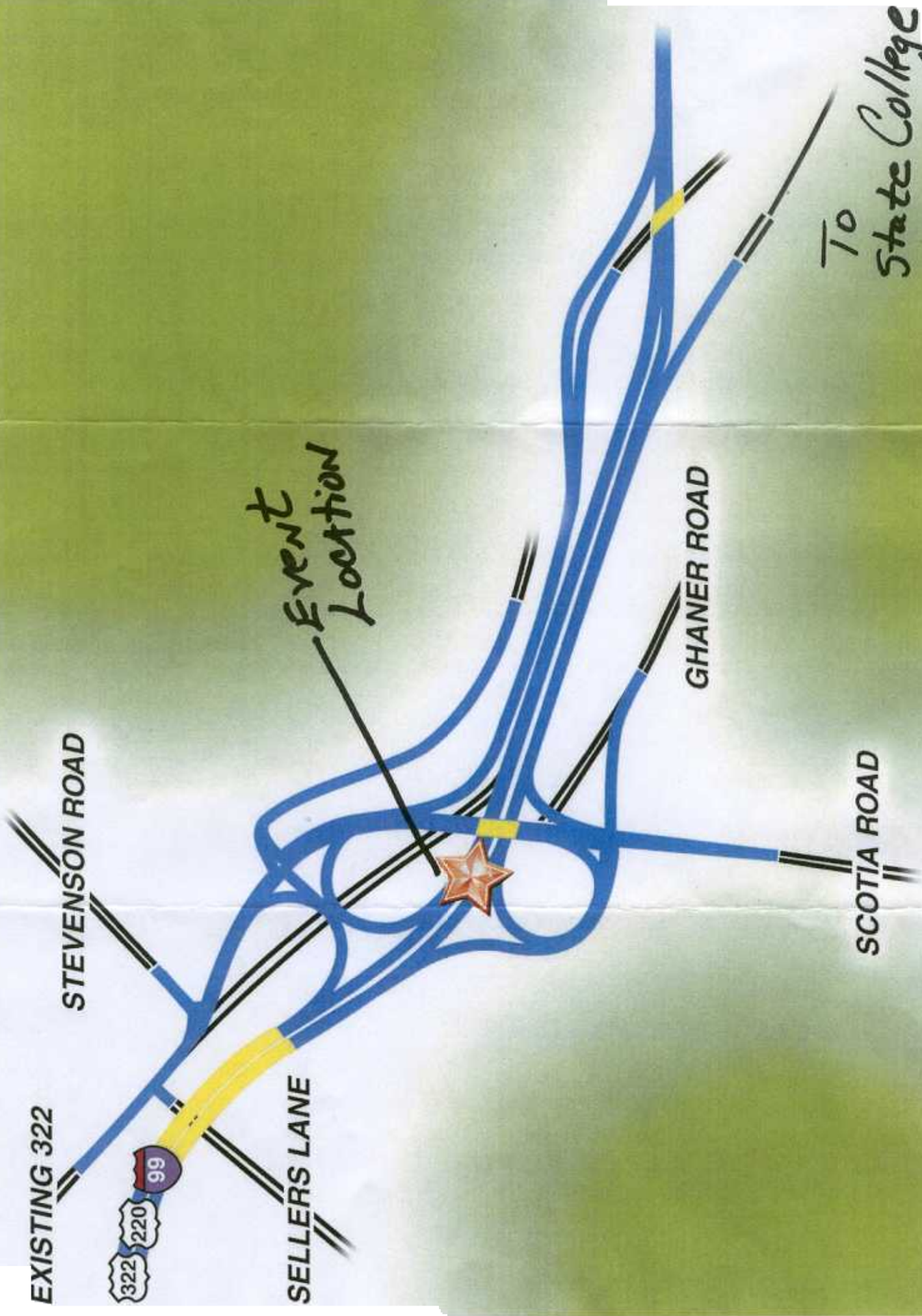
We hope that you can join us for this long-awaited event, as construction of the I-99 highway comes to a finish.
